
Help Fund the Kittatinny Hall Faculty Annex



The southern wing of Kittatinny Hall—one of the oldest and most-loved buildings of campus—is called the Faculty Annex. This area has long served as the offices of the NJSOC Education Staff. In addition to extra closet space, the one bathroom serving the whole building is in this area. Drainage issues and dated systems and design choices, unfortunately, compromised the utility of the Faculty Annex, making it difficult for the Education Staff to accomplish its work. The lack of more bathrooms and a functioning kitchenette undermine the ability to use the historical Main Hall to its fullest.



The plan to renovate the Faculty Annex includes fully modernizing the Education Department offices, creating a small kitchenette adjacent to the Main Hall, building a new ADA-compliant bathroom, and rearranging storage space. The new Education Department space will include 3 interior offices (where there had been 2), additional intern space, and ample closet and attic storage. Rehabilitating the Faculty Annex will allow NJSOC’s Education staff to work in an environment that is tailored to their needs, while also significantly increasing the ability of the Main Hall to host functions and be accessed by mobility-impaired users.



The cost for this project is \$100,050 That amount is broken down as:

Materials (already donated)	\$2,500
Materials (to be donated or purchased)	\$4,500
Inhouse labor	\$5,000
Subcontractors	\$75,00
Soft Cost 15%	\$13,050
Total Project Cost	\$100,050
